





MONDAY: Monday of Holy Week Is 42:1-7 Jn 12:1-11 "Eternal Father, help me to pour out all of myself like a libation of costly oil, remembering that with every act of love we anoint Christ for his burial.'

Today's suggested penance: Say "I'm sorry" to someone who is alienated from you. (-Magnificat Lenten Companion, Lent 2017)

TUESDAY: Tuesday of Holy Week

Is 49:1-6 Jn 13:21-33, 36-38

"God of all mercies, you never tire of offering us freedom from sin and healing in your grace. Give us the courage to turn back in haste to Jesus our Savior.'

<u>Today's suggested penance</u>: Do something kind for those in prison.

Wednesday of Holy Week Is 50:4-9a Mt 26:14-25 WEDNESDAY: "Loving Father, your Son never tires of fishing in the depths of my heart. May I always hold the tension of his reel."

Today's suggested penance: Give alms to a needy person or cause

THURSDAY: Holy Thursday

Ex 12:1-8, 11-14 Cor 11:23-26 Jn 13:1-15

"On Sundays...the faithful are to remain from engaging in work or activities that hinder the worship owed to God, the joy proper to the Lord's Day, the performance of the works of mercy, and the appropriate relaxation of mind and body (cf. CIC, can. 1247)." (Catechism of the Catholic Church 2185) "Loving Father, instill in me a deep love for the humility of your Son."

Today's suggested penance: Buy someone a meal or

something to drink. (-Magnificat Lenten Companion, Lent 2017)

FRIDAY: Good Friday of the Passion of the Lord: Day of Fast & Abstinence Is 52:13-53:12 Heb 4:14-16; 5:7-9 Jn 18:1-19:42

"Sunday...is to observed as the foremost holy day of obligation in the universal Church' (CIC, can. 1246 § 1)). 'On Sundays and other holy days of obligation the faithful are bound to participate in the Mass' (CIC, can. 1247)." (Catechism of the Catholic Church 2192)

"Lord God, may I acknowledge your Son as the foundation and salvation of my life, and so be in communion with Joseph, Nicodemus, the good thief, and all who witness to your presence in every aspect of their lives.

Today's suggested penance: Make the Stations of the Cross.

(-Magnificat Lenten Companion, Lent 2017)

1st Station: Jesus is condemned to death

2nd Station: Jesus carries His cross 3rd Station: Jesus falls the first time

4th Station: Jesus meets his mother

5th Station: Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus to carry his cross

8th Station: Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem

9th Station: Jesus falls a third time

10th Station: Jesus clothes are taken away 11th Station: Jesus is nailed to the cross 12th Station: Jesus dies on the cross

13th Station: The body of Jesus is taken down from the cross

14th Station: Jesus is laid in the tomb
