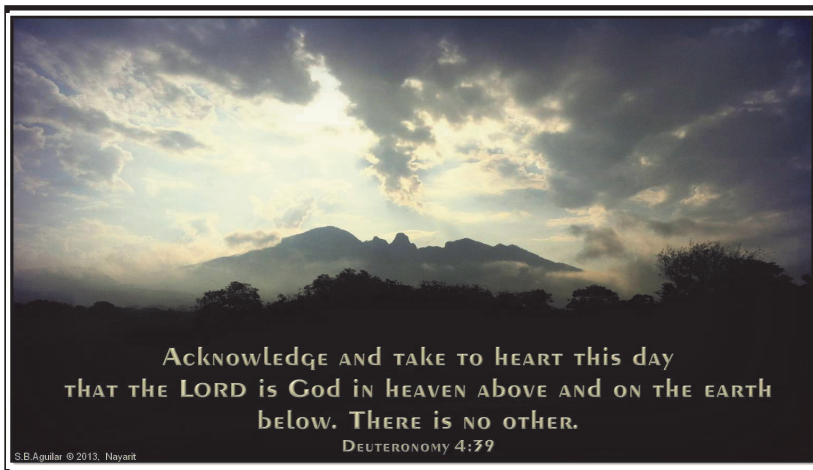

Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary
This Feast recalls to us the following great truths and events: The visit of the Blessed Virgin Mary to her cousin Elizabeth shortly after the Annunciation; the cleansing of John the Baptist from original sin in the womb of his mother at the words of Our Lady's greeting; Elizabeth's proclaiming of Mary, under the inspiration of the Holy Ghost, as Mother of God & "blessed among women"; Mary's singing of the sublime hymn, *Magnificat* ("My soul doth magnify the Lord") which has become a part of the daily official prayer of the Church. The Visitation is frequently depicted in art, & was the central mystery of St. Francis de Sales' devotions. The Mass of today salutes her who in her womb bore the King of heaven & earth, the Creator of the world, the Son of the Eternal Father. It narrates the cleansing of John from original sin in his mother's womb. Hearing herself addressed by the most lofty title of "Mother of the Lord" & realizing what grace her visit had conferred on John, Mary broke out in that sublime canticle of praise proclaiming prophetically that henceforth she would be venerated down through the centuries: "My soul doth magnify the Lord, & my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Savior. Because he that is mighty, hath done great things to me, & holy is His name" (Lk. 1:46). —Excerpted from the *Cathedral Daily Missal* (catholicculture.org)

FRIDAY: 1 Pt 4:7-13 Mk 11:11-26

Memorial of St. Justin, martyr

St. Justin, apologist & martyr, was one of the most important Christian writers of the second century. He himself tells how his study of all the schools of philosophy led him to Christianity, & how he dedicated his life to the defense of the Christian faith as "the one certain and profitable philosophy." St. Justin is particularly celebrated for the two Apologies which he was courageous enough to address in succession to the persecuting emperors Antoninus & Marcus Aurelius. One of them contains a description of the rites of baptism & the ceremonies of Mass, thus constituting the most valuable evidence that we possess on the Roman liturgy of his day. He was beheaded in Rome in 165. Justin is also referred to as "the Philosopher." (catholicculture.org)

SATURDAY: Jude 17:20B-25 Mk 11:27-33

Memorial of Sts. Marcellinus and Peter, martyrs

St. Peter & Marcellinus are two Roman martyrs who suffered under the Diocletian persecution, about the year 303; the first was an exorcist, the second a priest. Their cultus was so important that after peace was restored to the Church, Constantine built a basilica in their honor. Their names are mentioned in the Canon of the Mass (Eucharistic Prayer I). SUNDAY: Ex 24:3-8 Mk 14:12-16,22-26

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ
While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, & said, "Take it; this is my body." Then he took a cup, gave thanks, & gave it to them, & they all drank from it. He said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many." (catholicculture.org)

The Holy Trinity: Jesus appeared to the Apostles on the mountain top in Galilee, so they could receive their final instructions. They were to go forth, baptize, & make disciples, and to teach what they had been taught. These are our instructions, too. Once we meet Jesus and experience his love for us, we can't keep him to ourselves. We must share him. Jesus also revealed to the Apostles, and to the crowd gathered with them, that God is a Trinity-Father, Son, & Holy Spirit—three Divine Persons united in love. The belief that God is three, yet one, is distinct to Christianity. When we became members of the Church, we were baptized in the name of the Trinity. It is a mystery we may not fully understand, but we can still live in its love and power. We proclaim our faith in it whenever we make the Sign of the Cross.
