

On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court legalized abortion throughout the United States in its companion decisions *Roe V. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton.* Since that time, millions of children have lost their lives, and millions of women and families have been wounded by abortion. On June 24, 2022, the *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* decision overturned *Roe v. Wade*, and we praise God for the great opportunity state and federal legislators now have to protect pre-born children. While God, in His mercy, ended the nearly fifty-year nationwide regime of abortion on demand, **right now state and federal laws, in many instances, are still hostile to pre-born children.** 

In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer of the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion. - USCCB
